The board approved a policy on suspected Misconduct, Dishonesty, Fraud, and Whistle-blower Protection.

Policy on Suspected Misconduct, Dishonesty, Fraud, and Whistle-blower Protection

If any person knows of or had a suspicion about misconduct, dishonesty or fraud, the Principal should be contacted. If the alleged wrongdoing concerns the Principal, then the President of the Board or other officer or director, as applicable, of the organization should be notified instead.

If the Principal or other officer of the organization receives information about misconduct, dishonesty or fraud, they shall inform the Board, which shall determine the procedure for investigating all credible allegations.

At all times, the privacy and reputation of individuals involved will be respected. There will be no punishment or other retaliation for the reporting of conduct under this policy. If the person providing the information requests anonymity, this request will be respected to the extent that doing so does not impede any investigation.
